Use this information to prepare for your great trip to Airstream in Jackson Center, Ohio!

START HERE

Find your way to Jackson Center, Ohio, which is about 70 miles north of Dayton. From I-75, take the exit for Rt 274 and head east.

If you have lost your email confirmation or didn't get it, please email us at info@randbevents.com or call us at 813-200-8877 for a replacement. Please print it out and bring it with you if possible.

Adult admission - Admission to Alumapalooza 2023, for five days: You haven't registered a campsite, so you'll need to book one at a nearby campground.

If you would like to add a campsite to your Admission tickets, please call 813-200-8877 before August 20, 2023.

REGULAR ARRIVAL


If your receipt does not say "Early Arrival", you should plan to arrive on **Tuesday**, **September 5 or later**. If you arrive over the weekend or Monday, you will be parked but you'll be charged an extra \$50 at the gate for Early Arrival.

You will drive past both the new and the original Airstream factory if you come in from the west. Do not turn in at either entrance. Follow the signs.

Continue .02 miles past the original Airstream Factory and turn left on N Main, at the stop light. Follow N Main 0.4 miles and turn left onto Jerry Drive. Stay on Jerry Drive (it turns left) to the north gate of the Airstream plant.

Our friendly parking crew will meet you at the gate to collect your receipt. They'll direct you to one of the parking areas. Be prepared to live without hookups for a few hours, as it takes some time for the water/electric crew to connect everyone.

If you need to dump the Airstream tanks before parking, go to the Airstream Service Center entrance and use the public dump station there, then turn around and follow the directions above to get to the north gate on Jerry Drive.


IF YOUR REGISTRATION SAYS "EARLY ARRIVAL - ARRIVE SEPTEMBER 1-4":

These directions apply only to people who have receipts that say "Early arrival". If that's you, you can arrive over Labor Day weekend or Labor Day. Early parking starts Friday afternoon and continues through Monday, ending each day at 6:00 pm. If you are arriving after 6:00 PM you may need to spend the night boondocked in the lot or on Jerry Drive (see page 1)

IF YOU HAVE BOOKED AN ELECTRIC OR GENERATOR CAMPSITE (this applies to most people):

Turn on to Airstream Drive at the stop light, and take the second right tun into the west service center parking area.

Our friendly parking crew will meet you at the gate to collect your receipt. They'll direct you to one of the parking areas. Be prepared to live without hookups for a few hours, as it takes some time for the water/electric crew to connect everyone.



This map is for early arrival only. See page 2 if arriving on September 7 or later.

IMPORTANT: Please bring a printed copy of your registration email with you to show when you arrive.

The parking crew will meet you at the gate and direct you to a site, during the day before 6:00 p.m. Some sites are back-in sites, so tell the parking crew if you need a pull-through.

If you arrive after 6:00 p.m., the gate may be closed so be prepared to spend the night parked on the entry road (Jerry Drive) until the gate opens in the morning.

Arrive with full water and empty gray/black holding tanks because you may not have hookups until the event starts on Tuesday.

THINGS EVERYONE NEEDS TO KNOW

ELECTRIC SITES will have 4 trailers sharing a 20 AMP, which is for keeping your batteries charged. You will be sharing this power with many other people, so don't try to run air conditioning, microwave, and other AC-powered appliances or you'll trip a breaker and upset all your neighbors.

Makes sure your refrigerator is on "Gas" setting, not "AC'. If you have a 12 Volt DC only refrigerator you have been parked with others that will allow you to run it. Using DC-powered appliances (lights, water pump, furnace, 12v fan, etc.) is OK. Please, no generators at the electric sites!

GENERATOR SITES have no electrical connections, but you can run your generator anytime between 8:00 a.m. and 10:00 p.m.

WHAT ABOUT THE TERRA PORT?

The Terra Port spaces will be locked on the Labor Day weekend and unlocked only for people who are on the list of confirmed service appointments.

REGISTRATION

When you pull through the gate and are checked in you will be given your goody bag. One bag per trailer or group. If you are a walk in attendee and registered before August 15th you will get one goody bag per group.

Your goody bag will contain the full event program, name badges (which serve as your dinner & door prize tickets), and a bunch of other stuff. The T-shirts that you pre ordered will be in the bag. If there is a need to exchange your shirt please see our event booth in the vendor tent to do exchanges as soon as possible. Exchanges end at 4:00 PM on Thursday.

Please wear your badges all the time! You need to show them to attend seminars, win prizes, enter contests, and get other perks we've arranged for you.

Schedule changes, daily door prize winners, and other important announcements will be made at 4:00 p.m. daily under the main tent.

GETTING AROUND

A free bus will run around the Airstream factory, and to the New Factor, parking area, from Tuesday through Friday from 8:00 until 6:00 pm.

SERVICE

Airstream's service department will be booked solid during this week, so if you want to get some service done, you must make an appointment in advance. Call 937-596-6111. There will be a service waiting list if you couldn't get an appointment during Alumapalooza.

AIRSTREAM PARTS

Parts can be ordered in advance and picked up in person or delivered to your site at Alumapalooza. Call Airstream Parts at 937-596-6111 well in advance, and tell them where you'll be parked (Factory Electric, or Factory Generator).

ZIP DEE PARTS

Want parts or accessories from Zip Dee delivered to you at Alumapalooza? Call in your order to Zip Dee at 800-338-2378 and specify that you want delivery at Alumapalooza.

FUEL

There's a Marathon gas station right next to Airstream.

WEATHER

What kind of weather can you expect? All kinds! Temperatures will often range from the upper 50s to the upper 90s during the week. Bring sunscreen and a rain jacket, and you'll probably use both in the same day!

INTERNET & PHONE

There's free wi-fi at the Airstream Service Center. For phones, Verizon and T Mobile work best.

GRAY/BLACK DUMPS

A free dump station is located next to the Airstream Service Center. One complimentary pump-out at your site is included with your registration. Your row will be pumped based on the date you were parked. Your notification will be a flag at the end of your row, placed by Alumapalooza staff.

MISCELLANEOUS

- No ground fires allowed, but an off-the-ground grill or fully contained fire is OK.
- Local ordinance says: No open containers off Airstream property.
- All animals must be caged or on a 6-foot (or shorter) leash. No pets in buildings except service animals.

Please be sure to secure your personal belongings, lock your vehicles, etc. The organizers of Alumapalooza and Airstream will not be responsible for lost or stolen items.

THINGS TO BRING

- Please bring a copy of your registration email with you for check-in.
- Bring two 25-foot fresh water hoses. You'll be daisychained to a common water line with other trailers. Bring a "Y" adapter to split the water line as well.
- Also bring a household (15-amp) electrical adapter for your power line, and 50-100 feet of electrical cord so you can reach the power.
- If you're going to perform in the Aluminum Gong Show, bring whatever you need. Guitar? Talented pet? Costume? Swords? Any interesting and family-friendly performance is welcome!
- **Bring groceries.** In Jackson Center there is only a Dollar General, for basic food and convenience items. The nearest full grocery is in Ana, 10 miles away.

- If you want to join the evening Jam Session, bring any musical instrument you have. If you want to participate in Open Mic Night, bring your vocal cords.
- If you've got things to sell, especially Airstream parts or collectibles, bring them for the Swap Meet on Saturday morning.
- For the "Open Grill" nights, bring something to grill with the other folks at Alumapalooza. Tongs and other grill tools are handy.
- The weather is highly variable, so bring clothes for all conditions, from hot to cold, sunny to rainy. Don't forget the sunscreen and camera!
- If you want to join the bike rides, bring a bike and a helmet!
